Our crew were on deck early and helped set up, prepare salads etc.

Rod was very happy as we were well in front so had time to sit down and relax awaiting arrival of the diggers.

"H" hour approached and we were given the go ahead to start cooking.

Some of us started to joke about calamities that had occurred on previous BBQ's. We even checked the weather radar for thunderstorms.

First batch of snags were cooked and ready to go, then it starts to rain lightly, then right on queue the gas BBQ goes out. Murphy strikes again – we had run out of gas!!!

Main Q Store is locked up, so RSM sent someone to check with Sgt's Mess, however no bottles.

Graham Elliott grabs the empty bottle to race away to find a Swap and Go.

Luckily Heather found an electric frypan to cook the prawns and then the Padre comes to the rescue and cooks up his seafood and garlic sauce.






RSAR Association Inc 2023 Annual General Meeting
